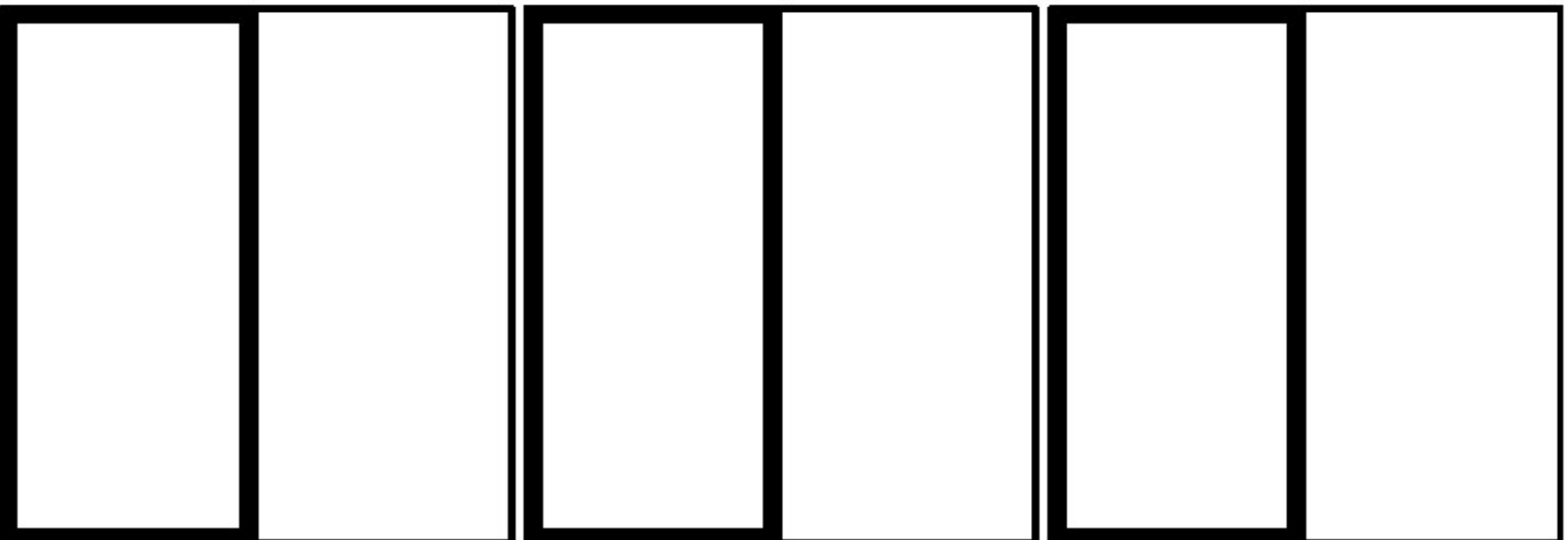


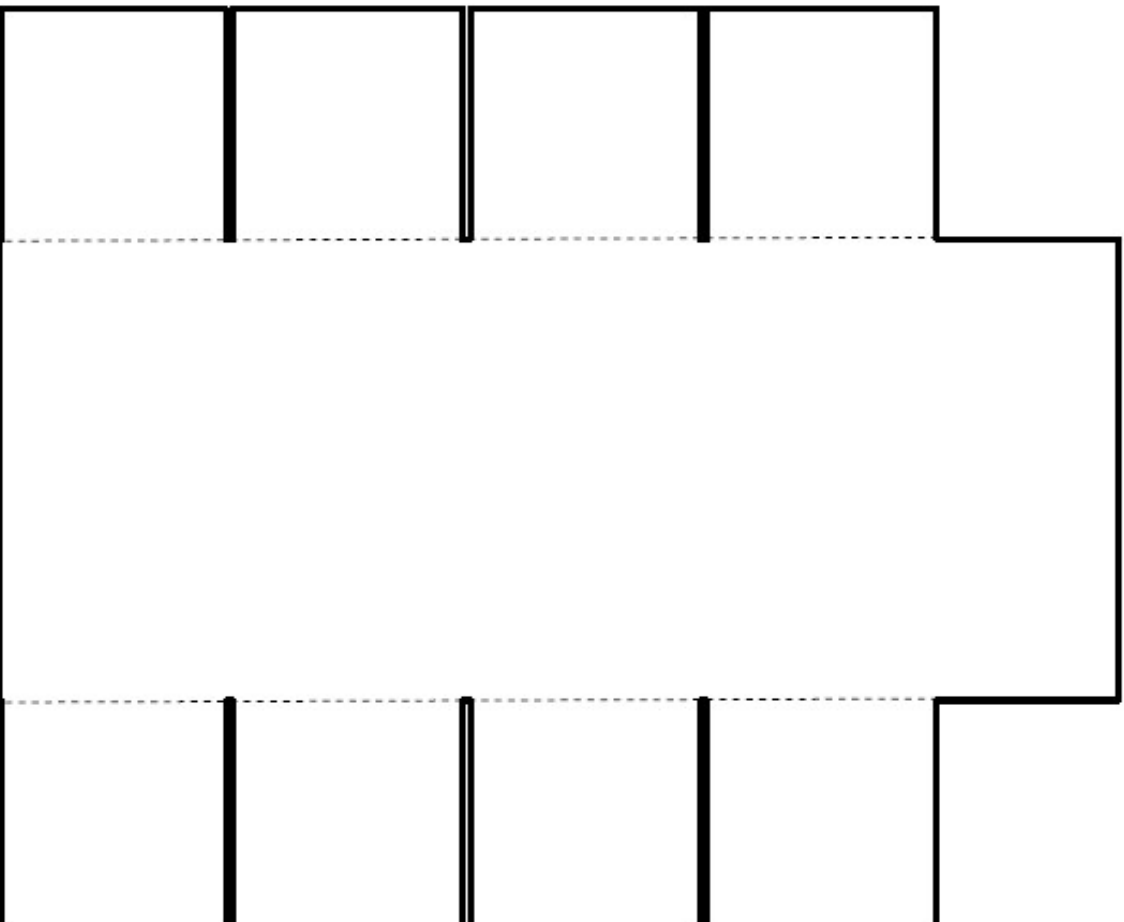
- Cut out each individual foldbook as one piece.

- Paste the three foldbooks inside each of the rectangles on the base panel.

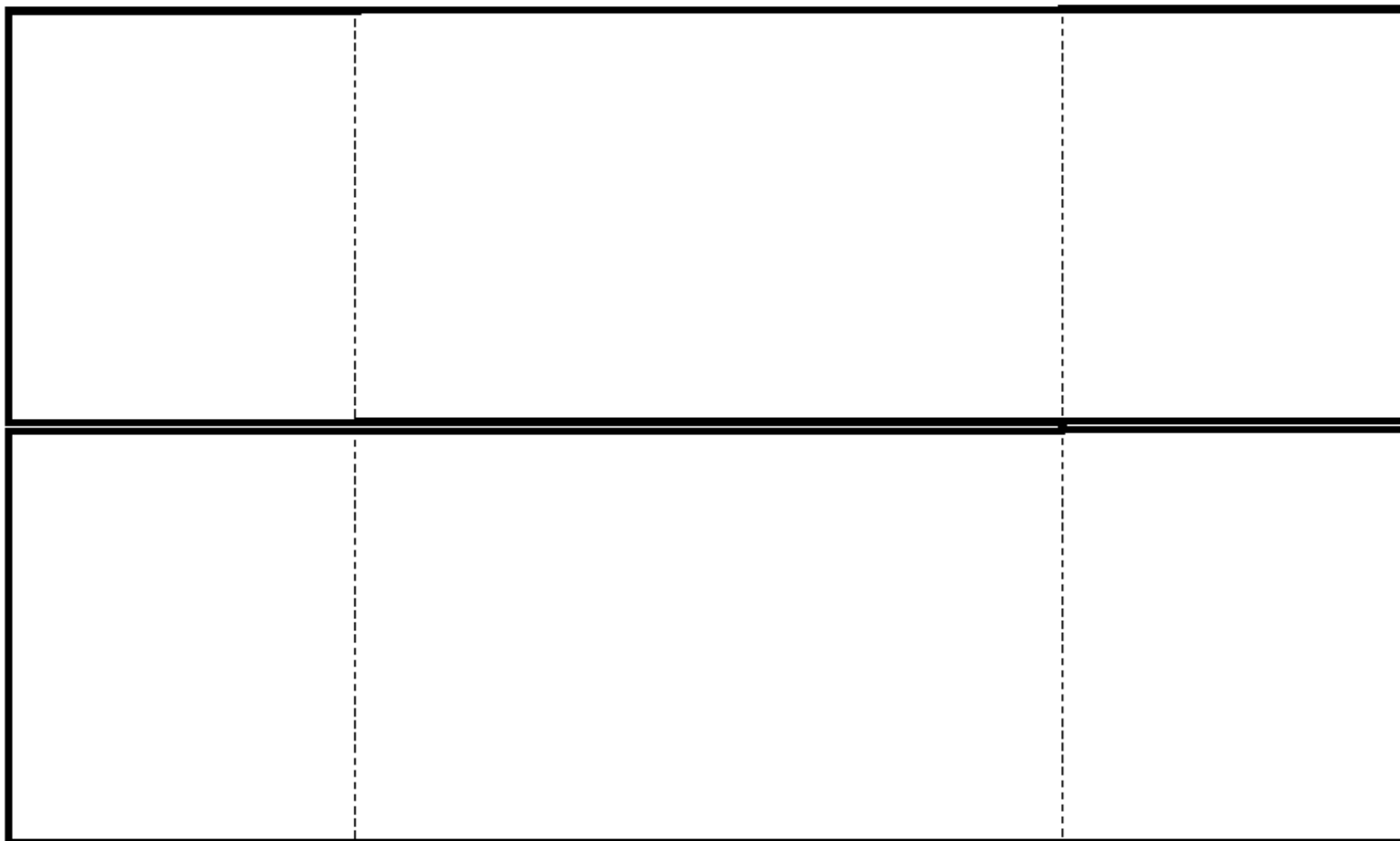
- Cut minibook out as one piece on the solid lines.

- Write title on the top center panel and label flaps as desired.

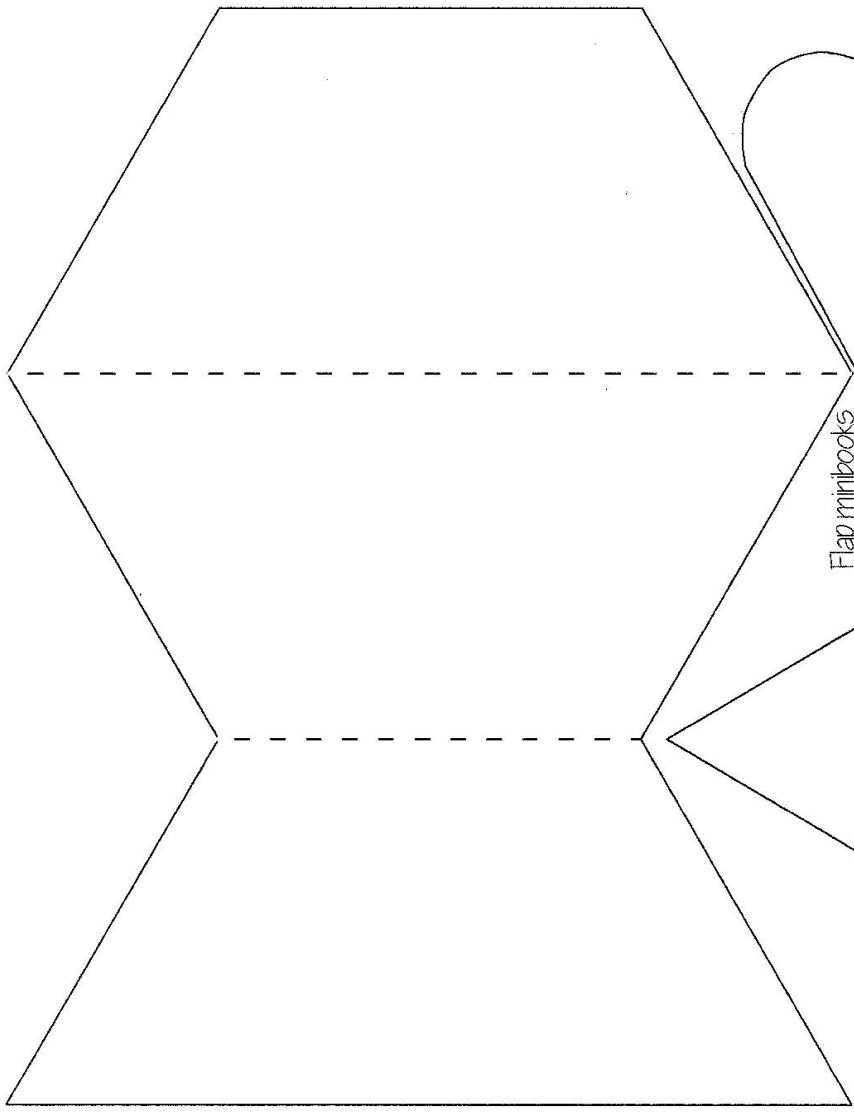


This is for two separate shutterfold minibooks.

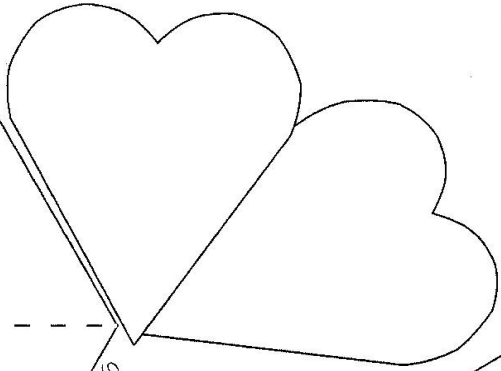

- Fold flaps inward on the dotted lines.

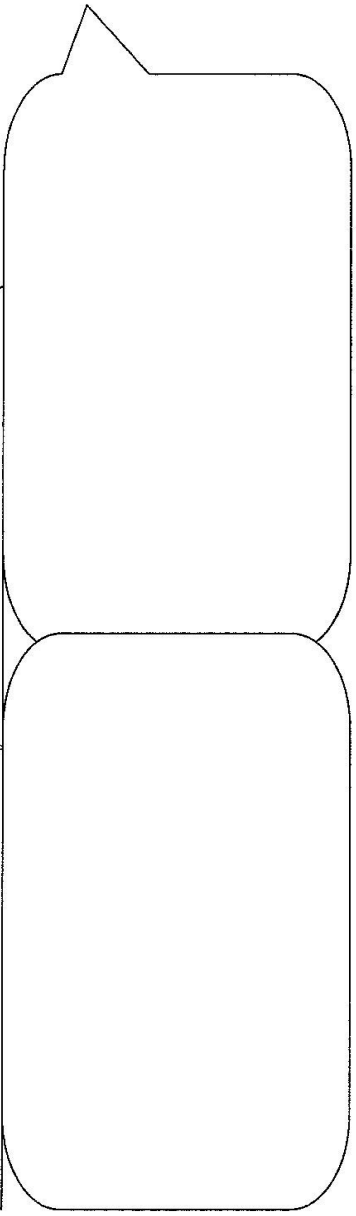
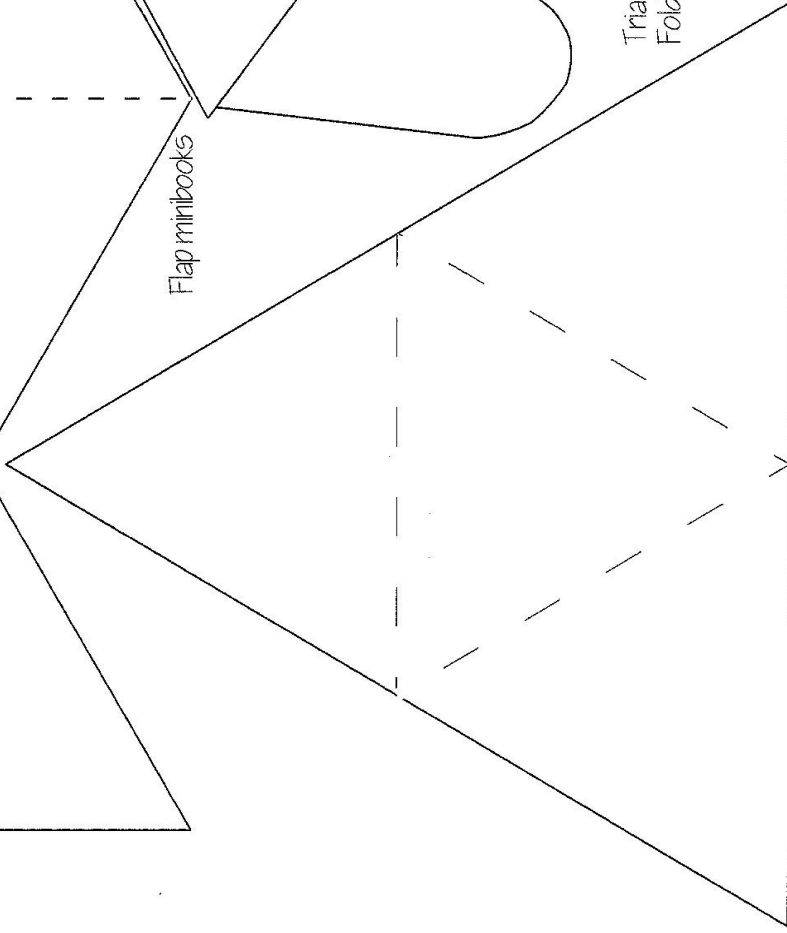


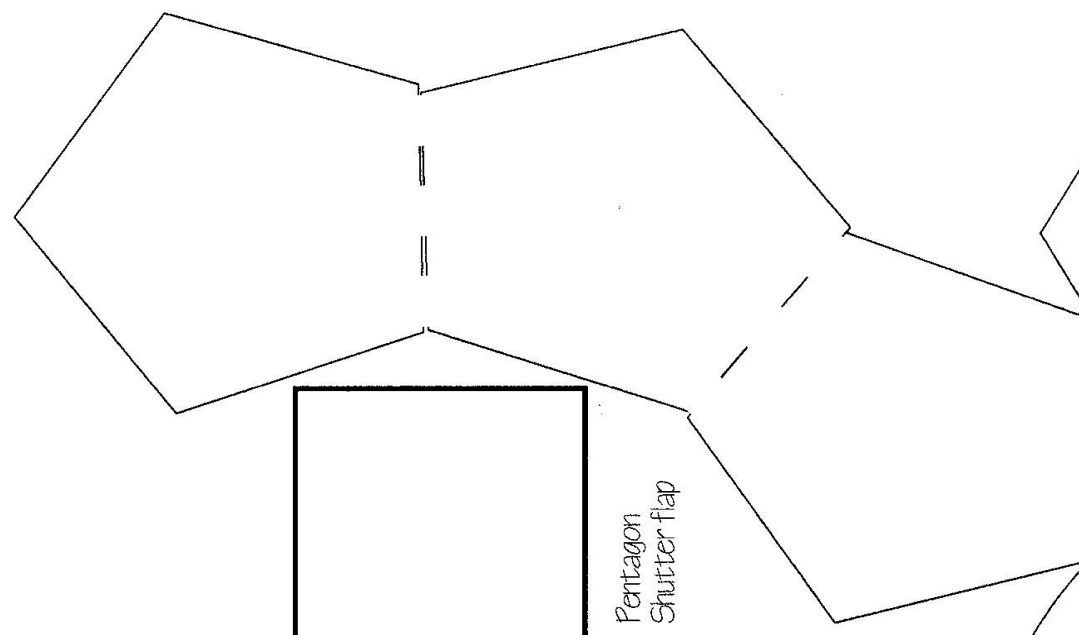

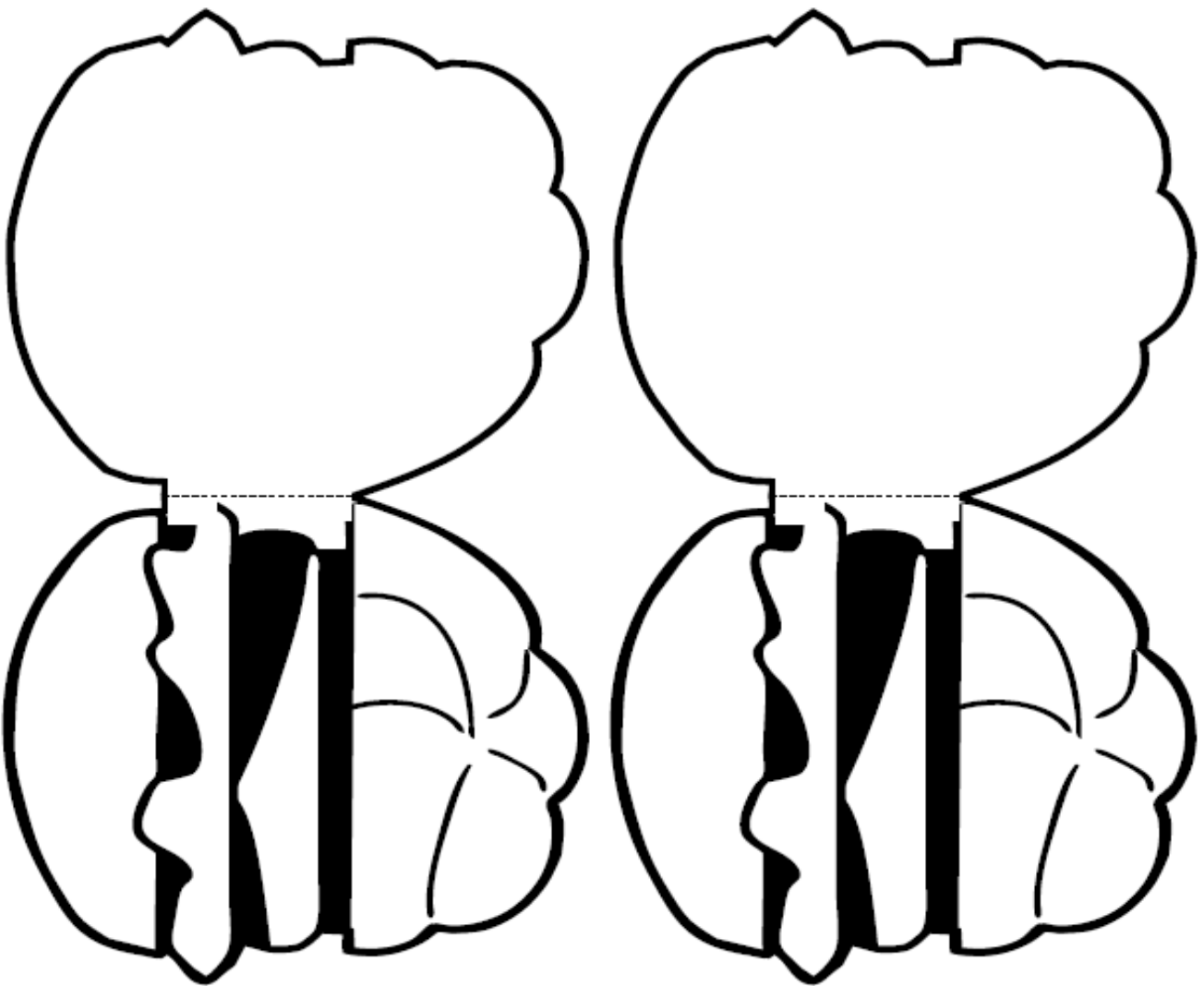


- Cut out on the solid lines as one piece.

- Label as desired.

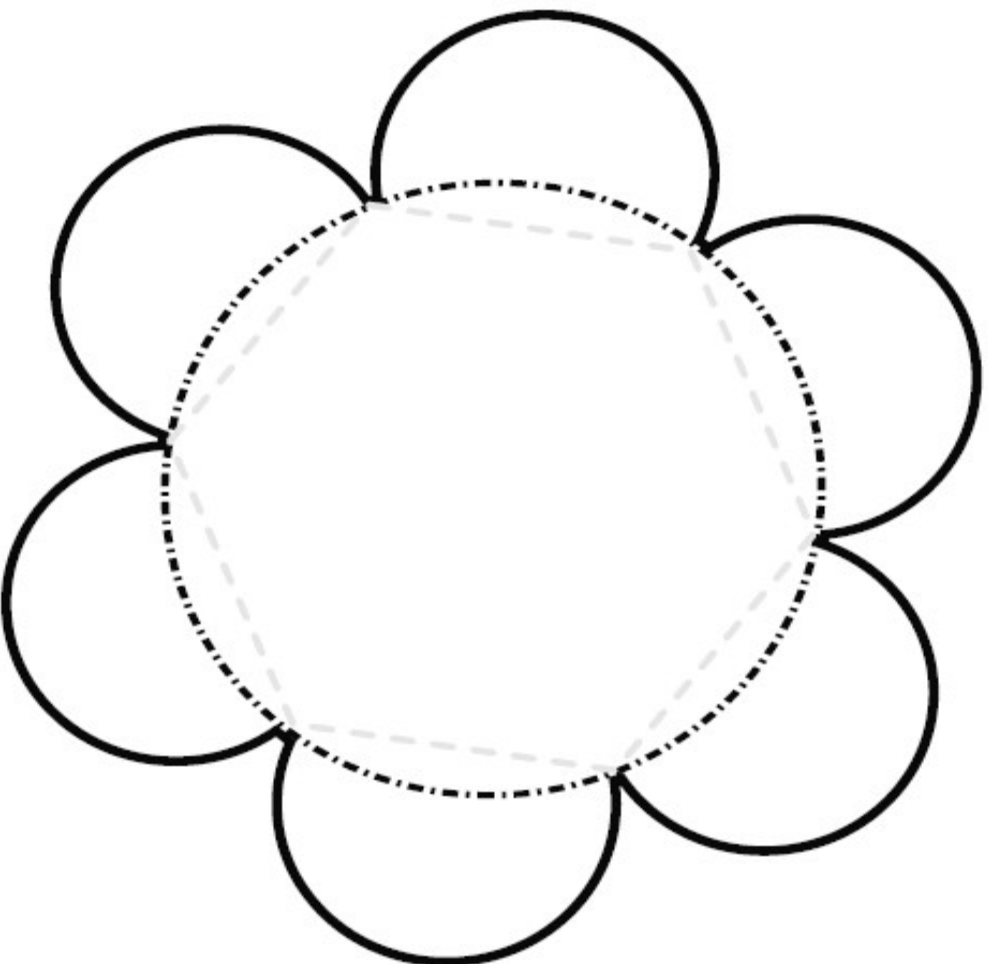


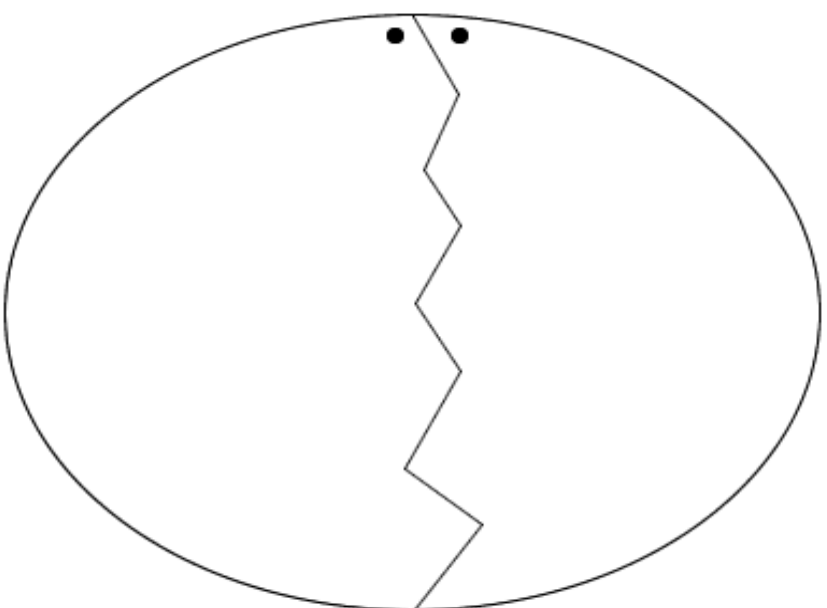
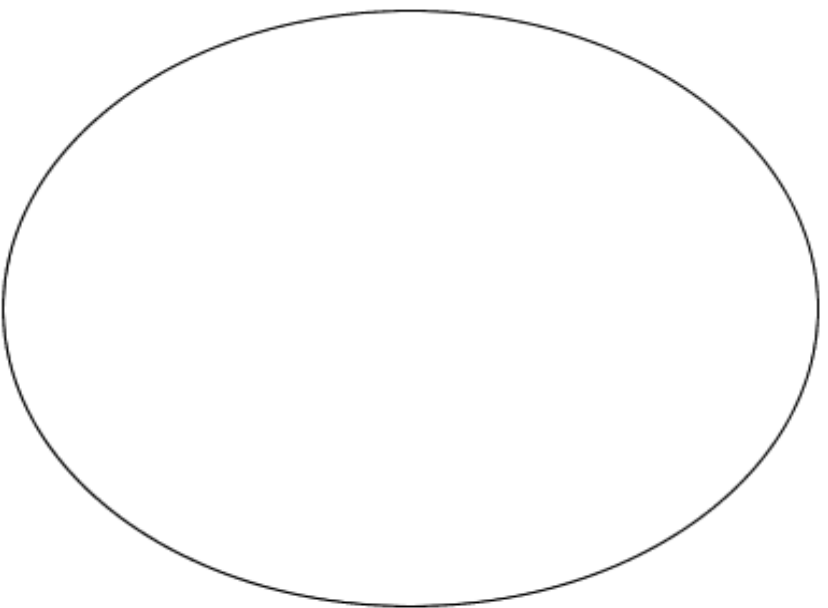


Cut out all along outer lines. Punch circles with a hole puncher. Put together with a brass fastener.

- Fold petals inward on the gray dotted lines of the hexagon.
- Label as desired.

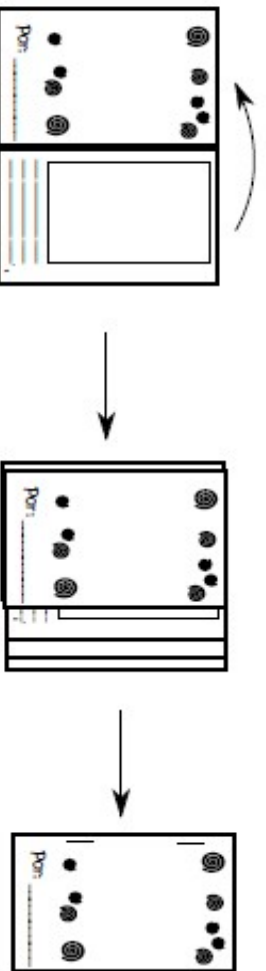




Cut out along solid lines.

Attach with a brass fastener.

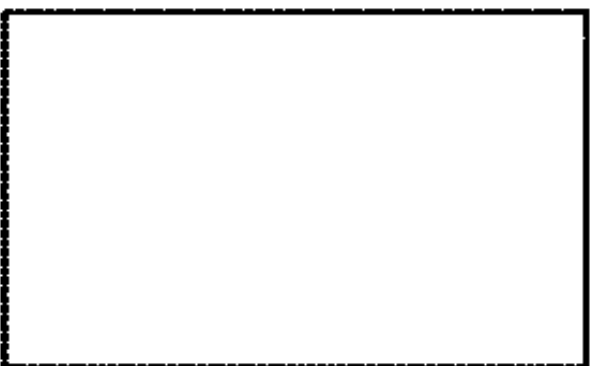
MiniBook Instructions

- Cut out each two pairs of pages as one rectangular piece.
- Fold each pair of pages in half with the graphics on the outside.
- Stack the pairs of pages on top of each other in order, starting with the title page.
- Staple on the left side.

1. Cut out the clock and the hands.
2. Put a hole in the dots on the hands and the x on the clock with the point of a pencil.
3. Place the hands on the x of the clock and stick a brass fastener through all three holes.



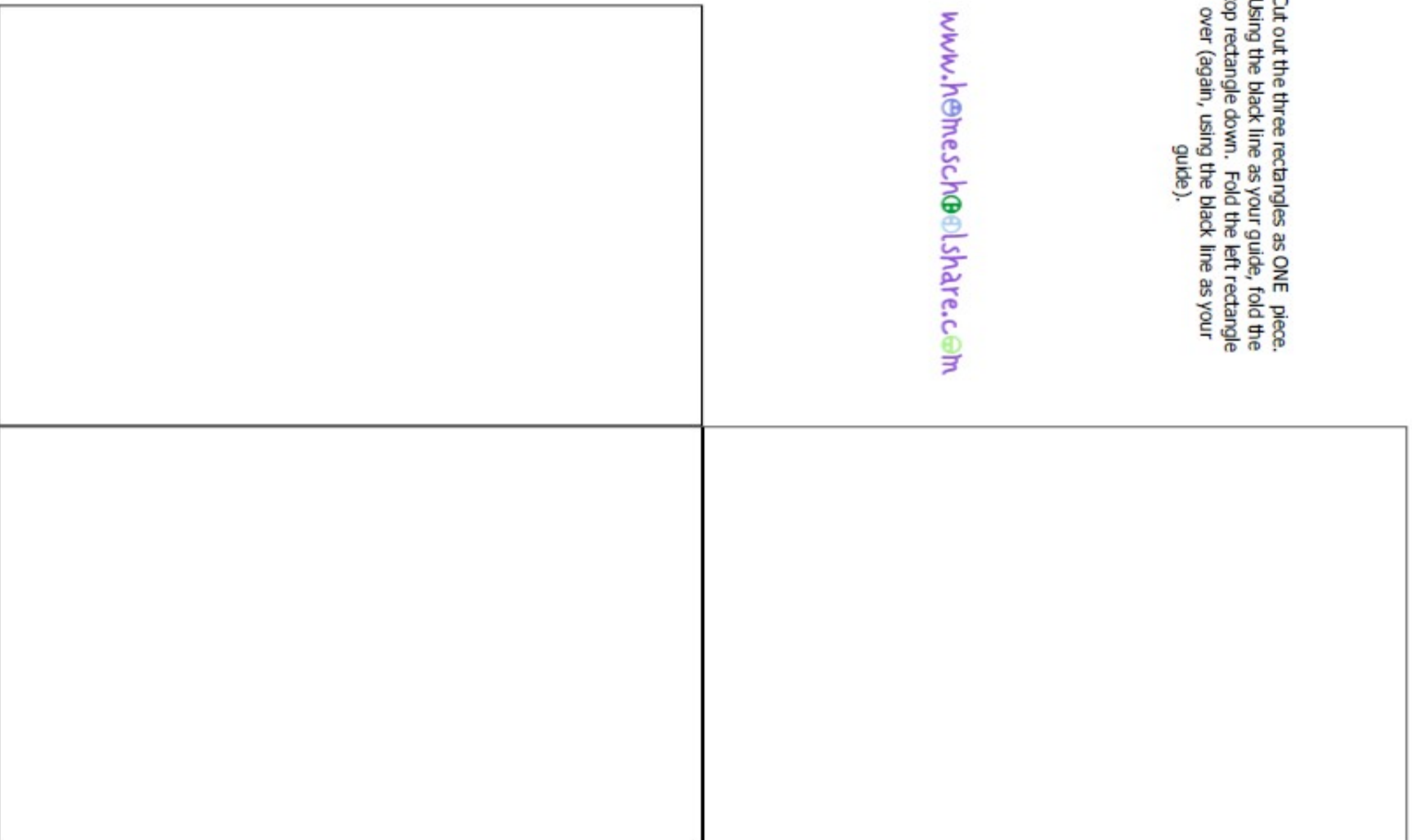


Cut out both circles along the outside dark lines. Cut out window on the circle with writing. Put the circle with the window on top of the other circle. Attach circles with a brass fastener at the middle, small circle.



Cut out the three rectangles as ONE piece.
Using the black line as your guide, fold the
top rectangle down. Fold the left rectangle
over (again, using the black line as your
guide).

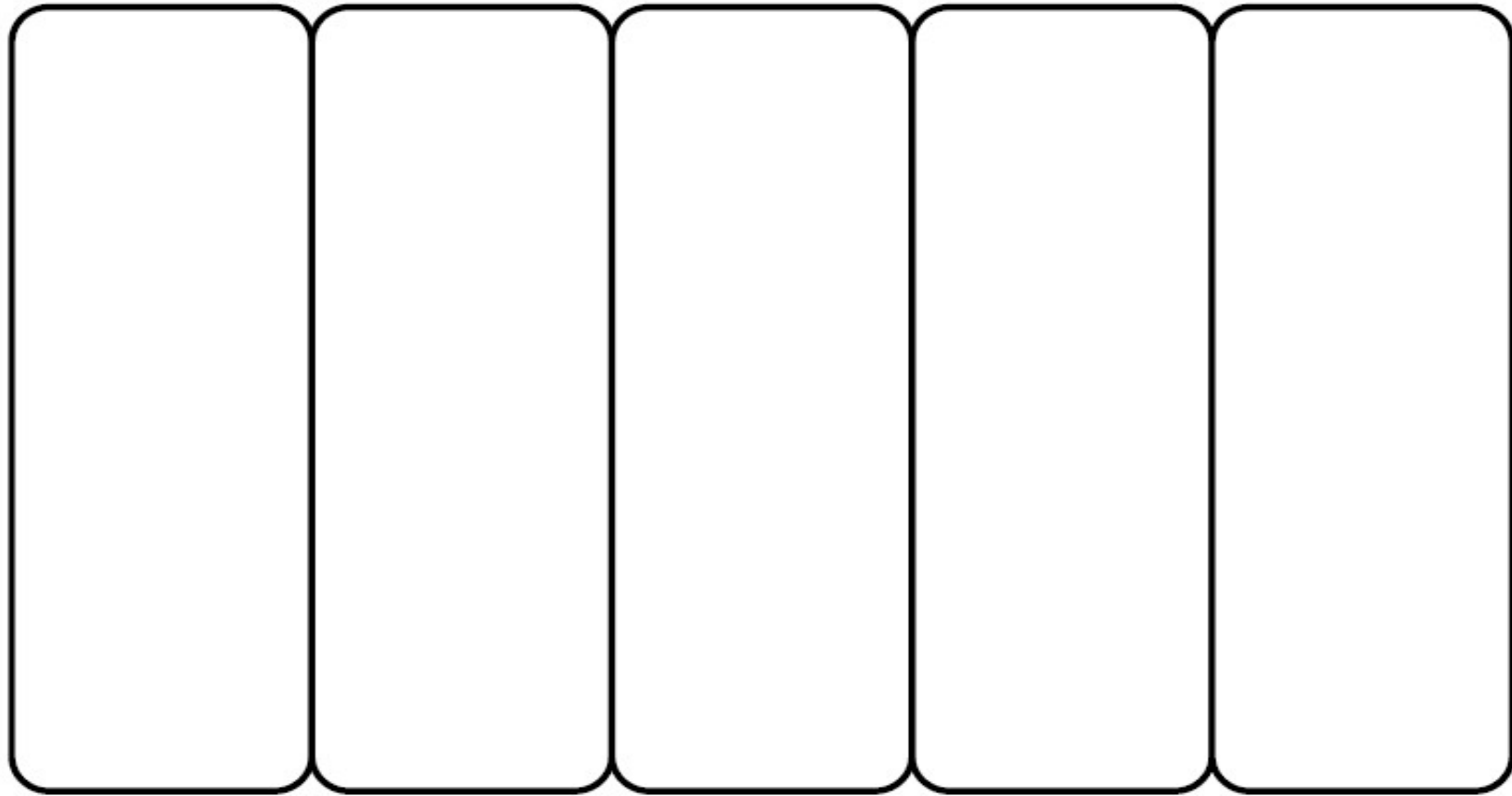


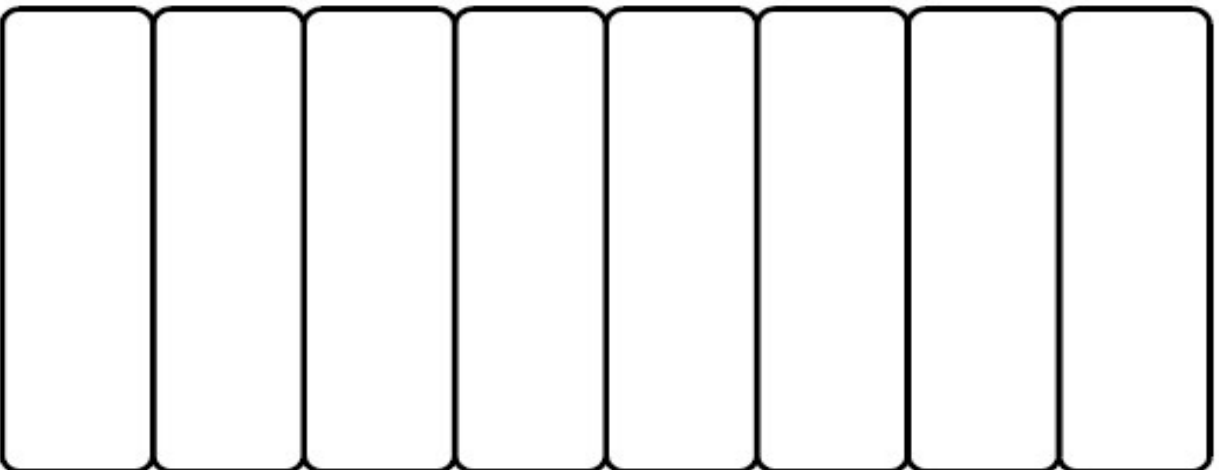
Cut L-shape out as ONE piece. Fold the top of the L shape down. Fold the left rectangle in over the existing flap.

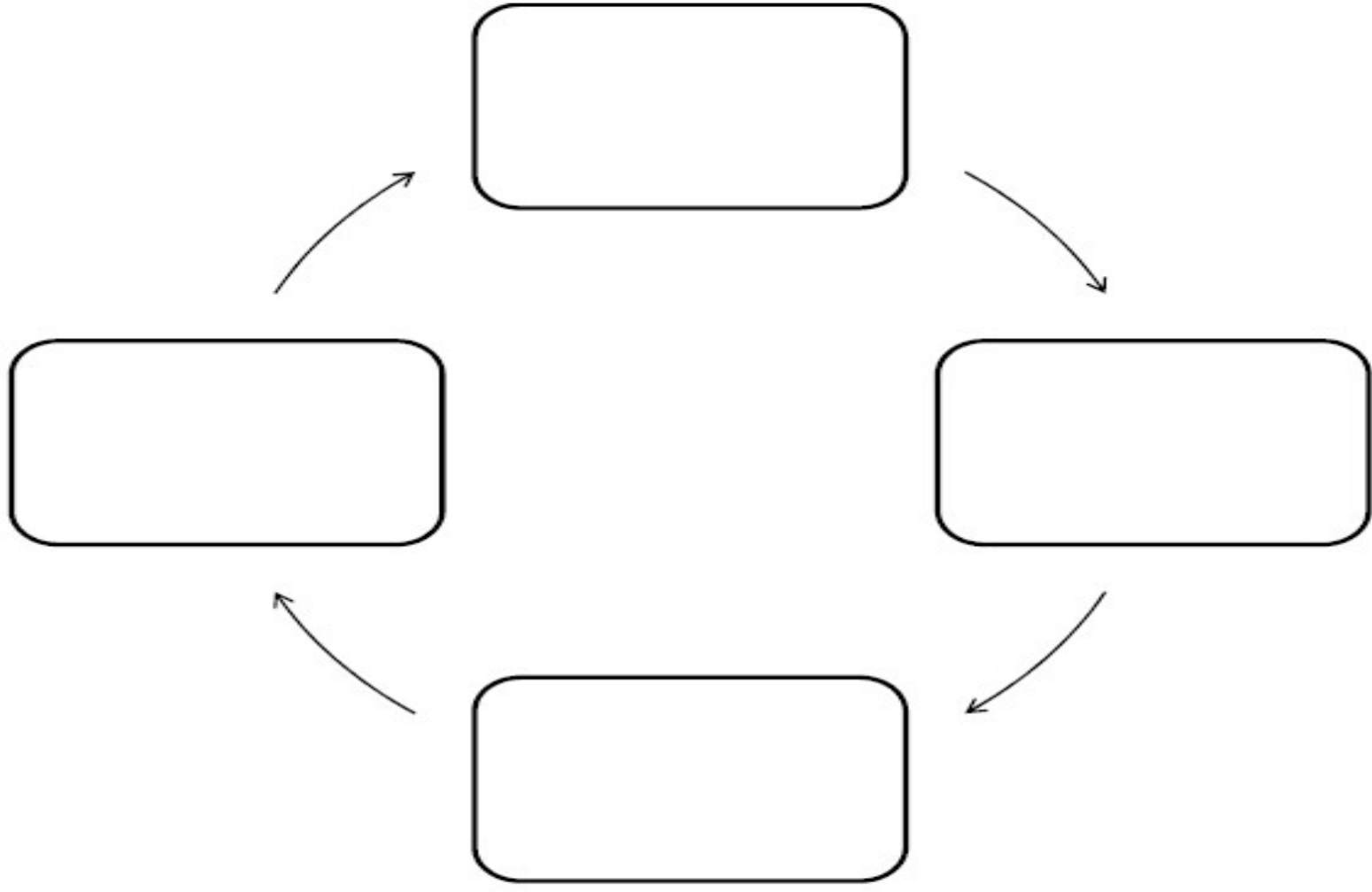


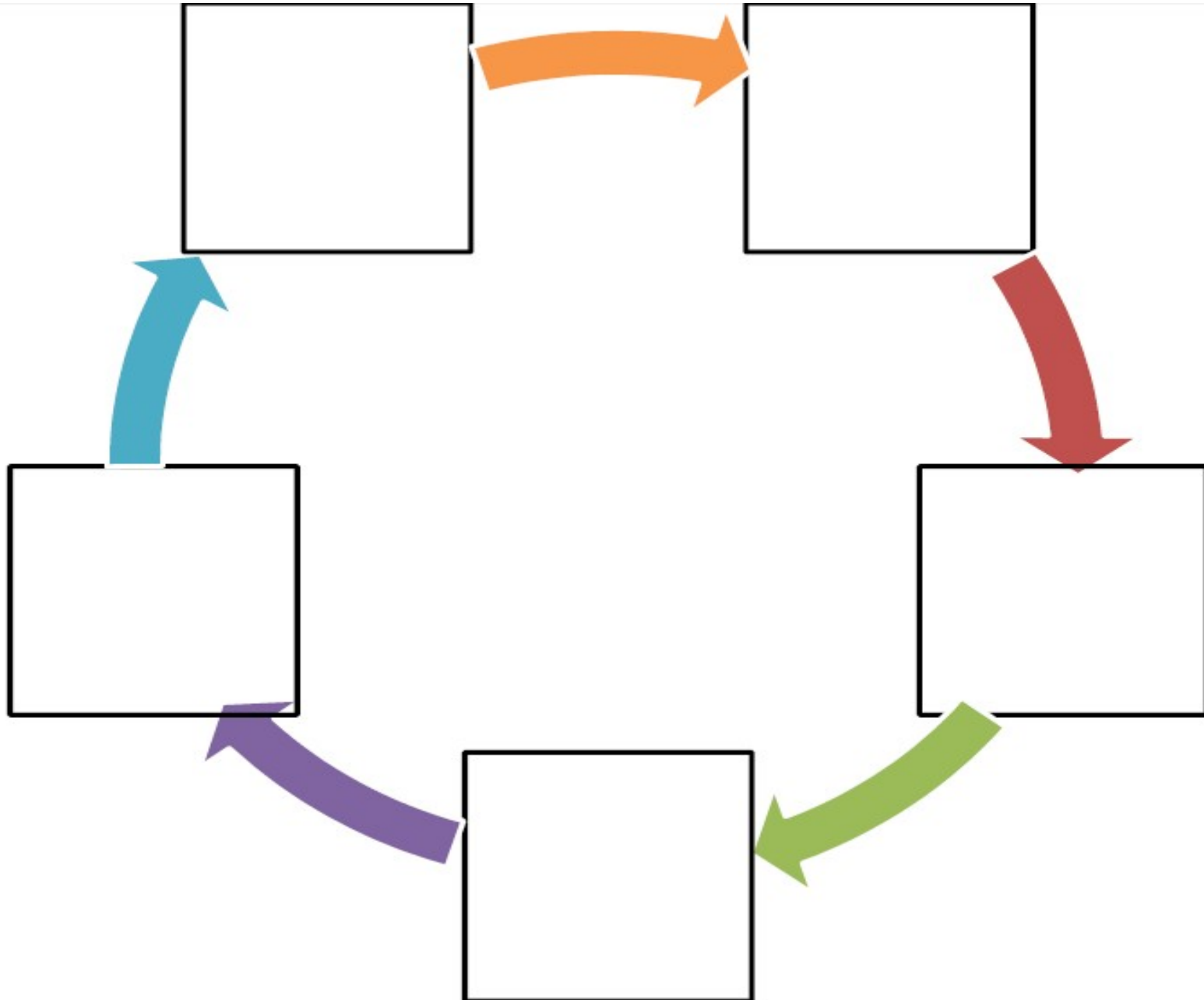
Cut book out as one piece. Fold right flap in. Fold left flap in. Fold in half. You should be able to use this book horizontally or vertically.

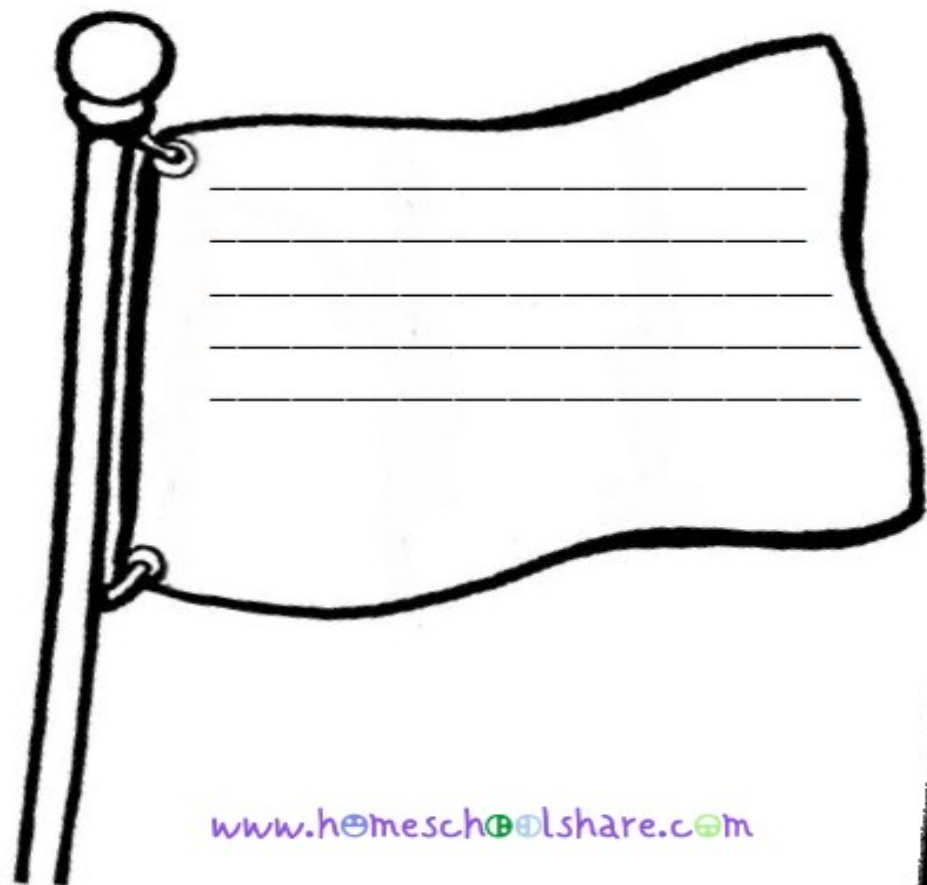






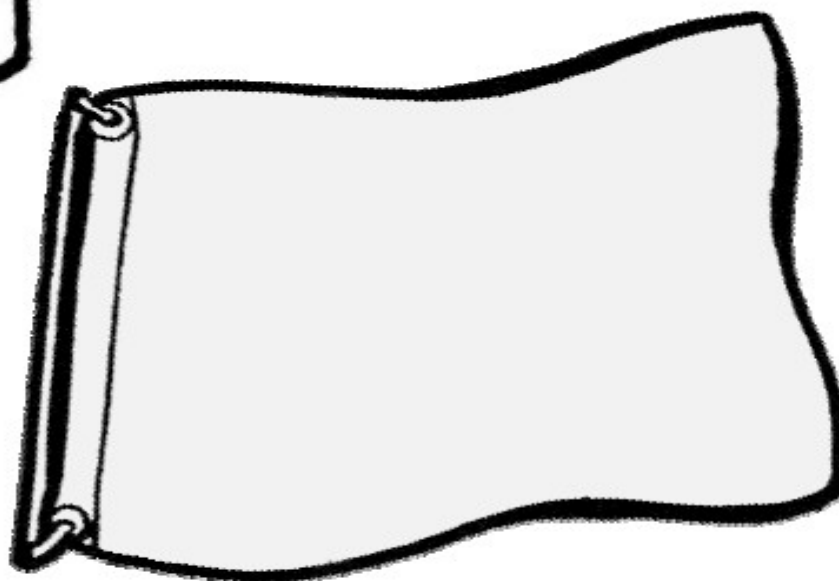






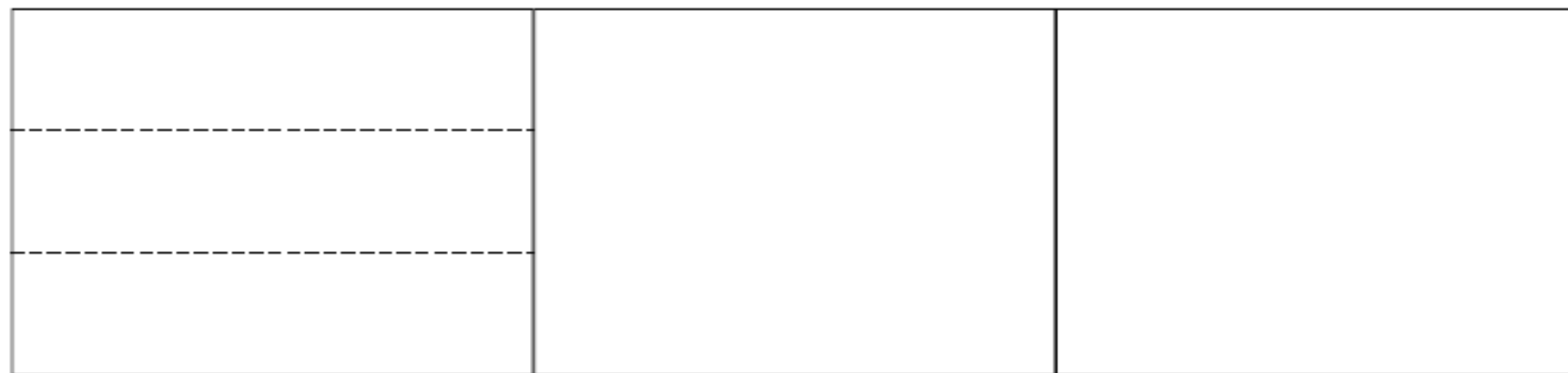
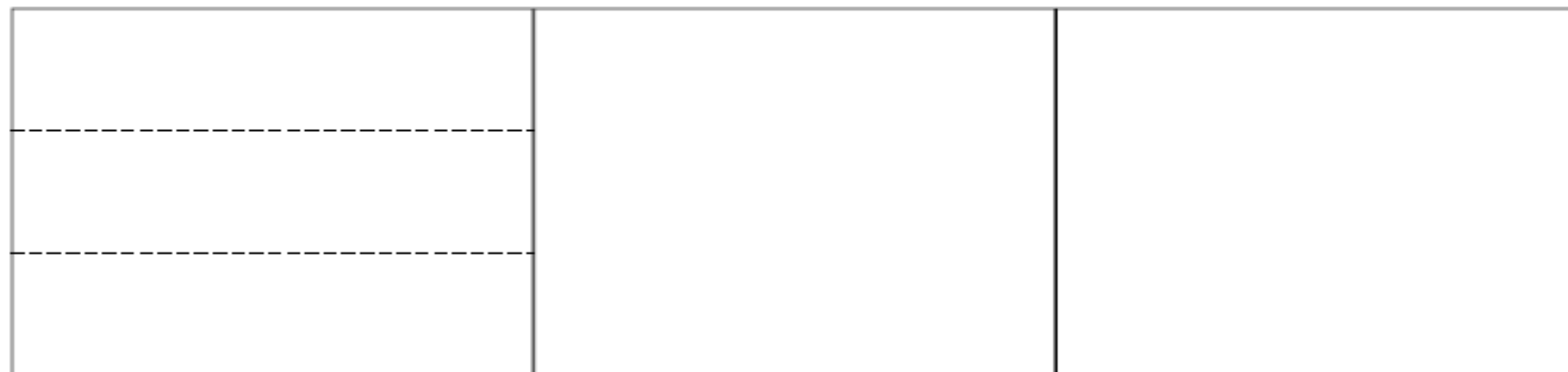
Cut each flag shape out. Stack in order with cover (Flag Facts) on top and staple on the left side.

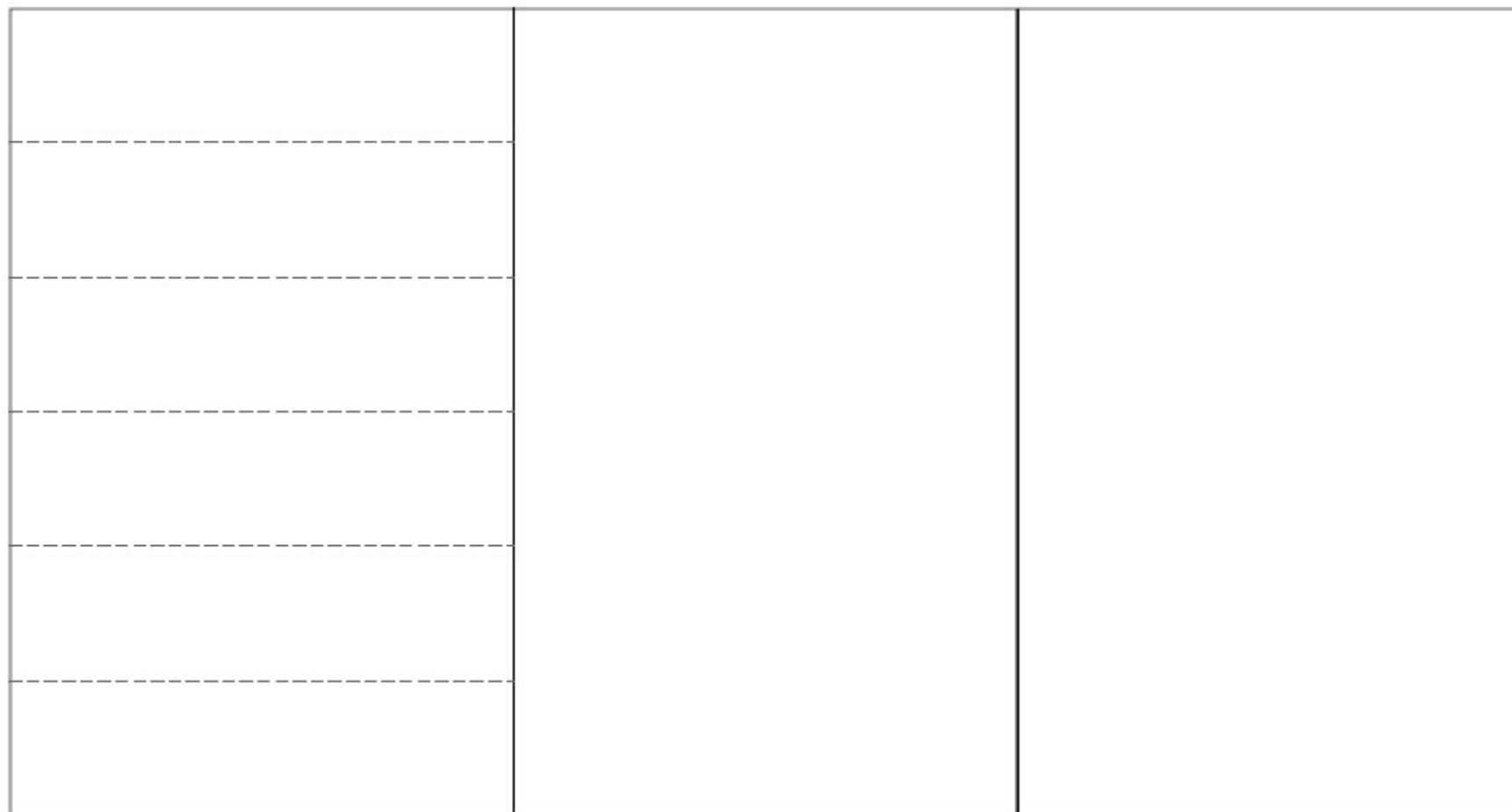
Cut out each book as one piece. Fold left side under. Fold right side under (it is the cover). Unfold book. Cut on the two lines between the names to form three flaps.

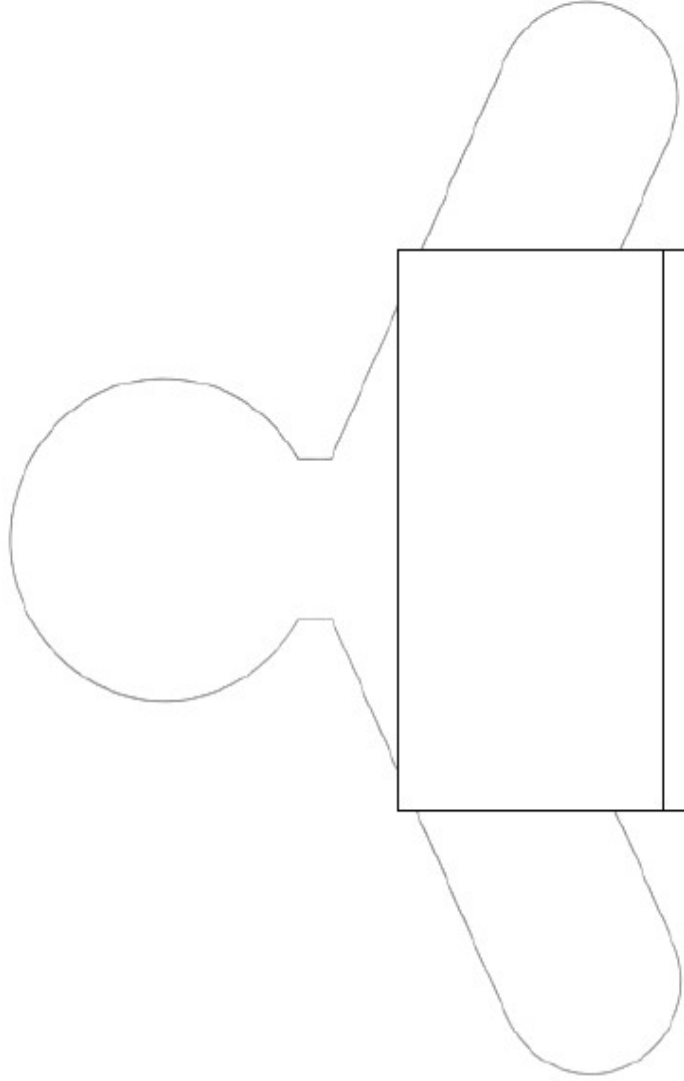
How to Fold a Mini Book (Eric Ode - www.ericode.com)

1. Fold the paper in its hot dog direction. Open it again.
2. Fold the paper in its hamburger direction. Leave it folded.
- 3a. Fold each side of the hamburger bun back toward the spine so that you end up with an accordion folded paper. (3b.) Bring those sides back out as a hamburger bun.
4. Cut the paper from the spine of the paper until you are half way through (stop at the fold from Step 3).
- 5a. Lay the paper down like a tent. Grab with forefingers on each side of the cut (5b.) and bring the two sides down and together. Then bring all flaps together to create the pages of your book.



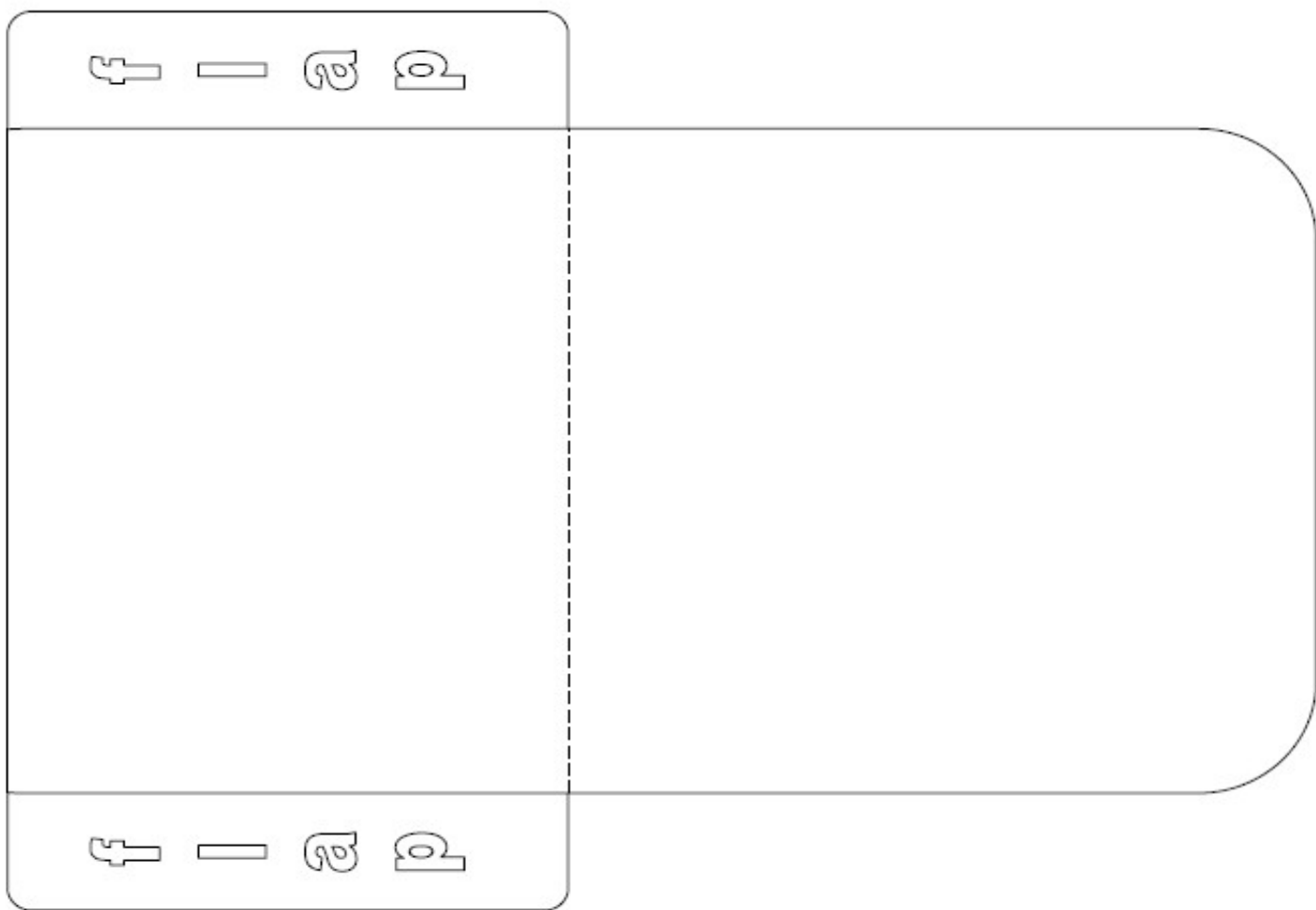

Glue the back of your pocket into your lapbook.

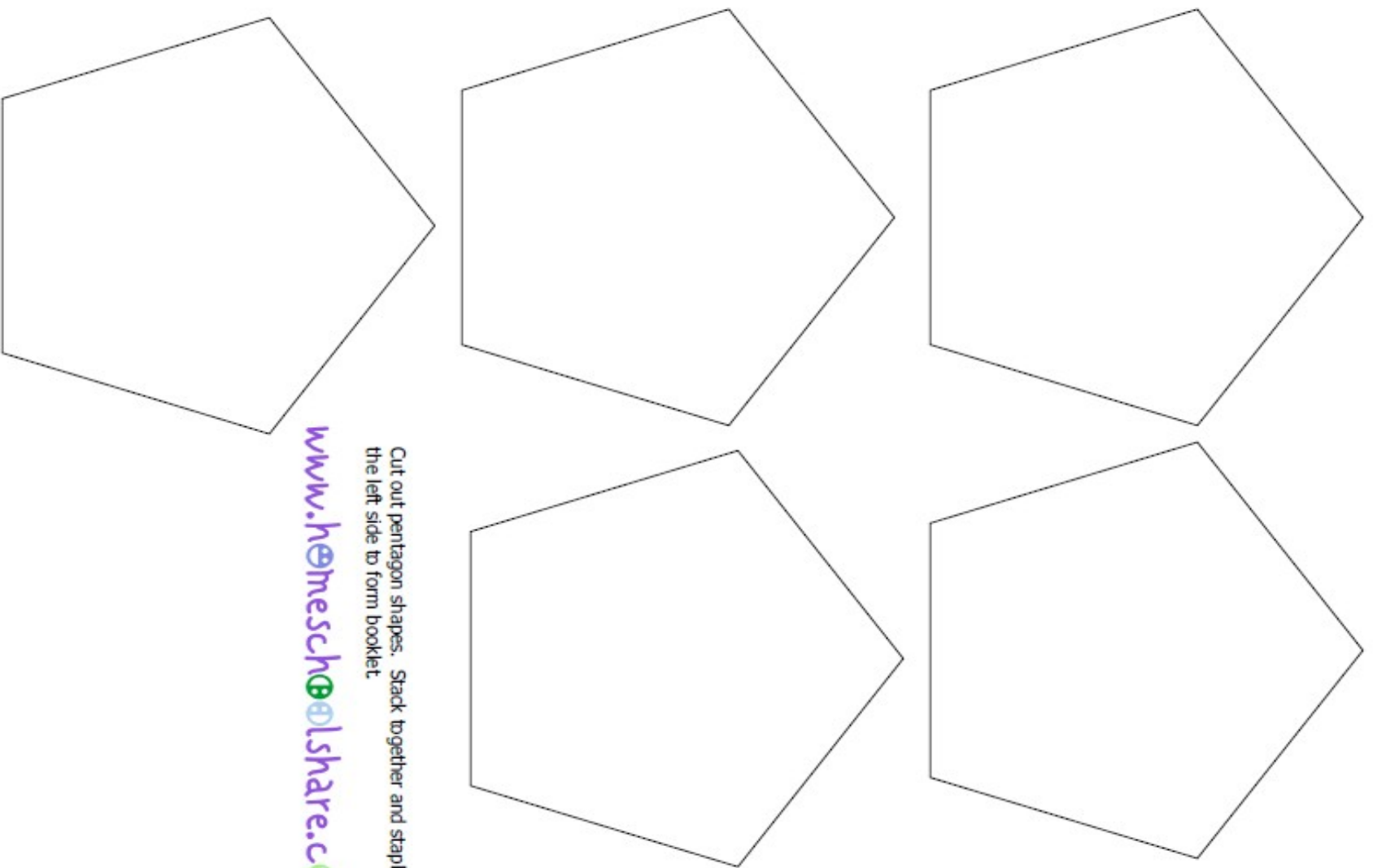

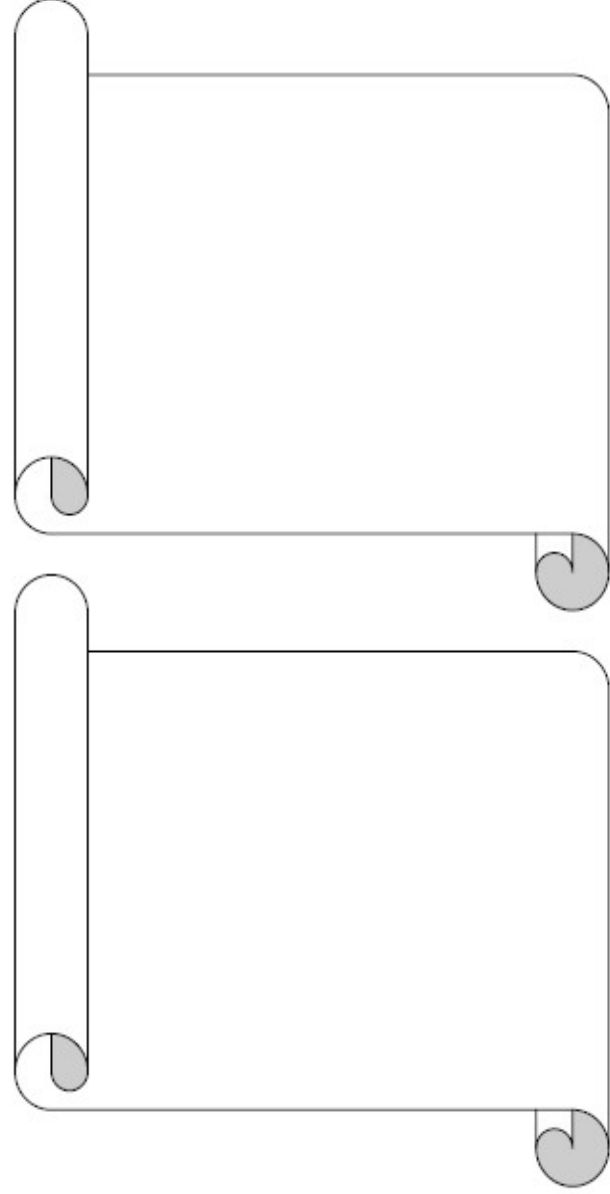
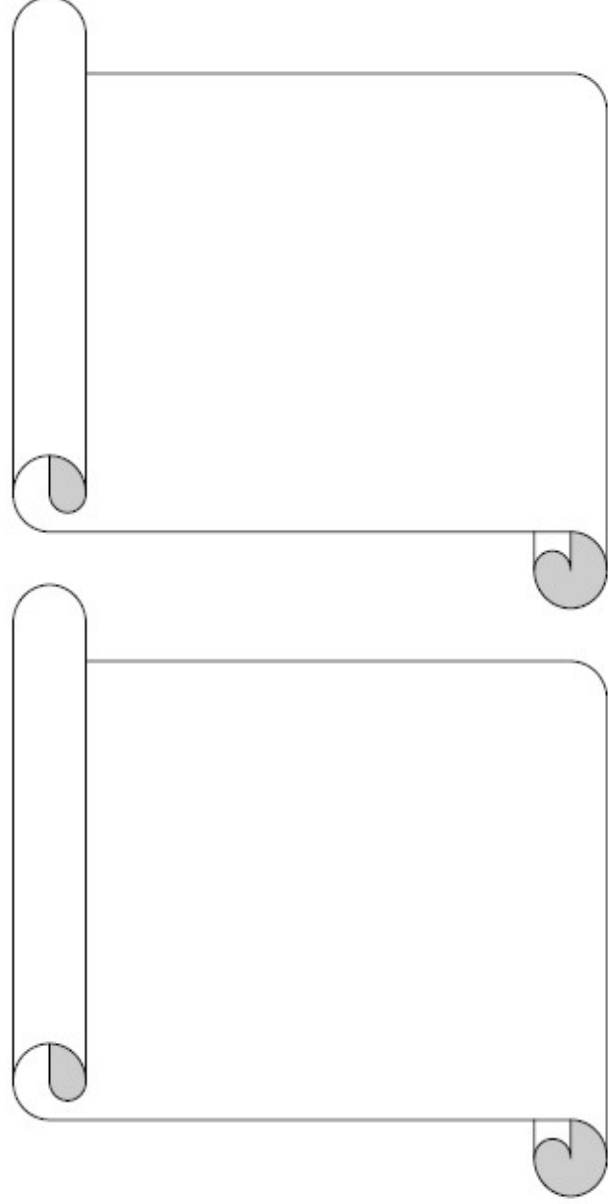
Cut out cylinder shapes. Stack together and staple on the left side to form booklet.

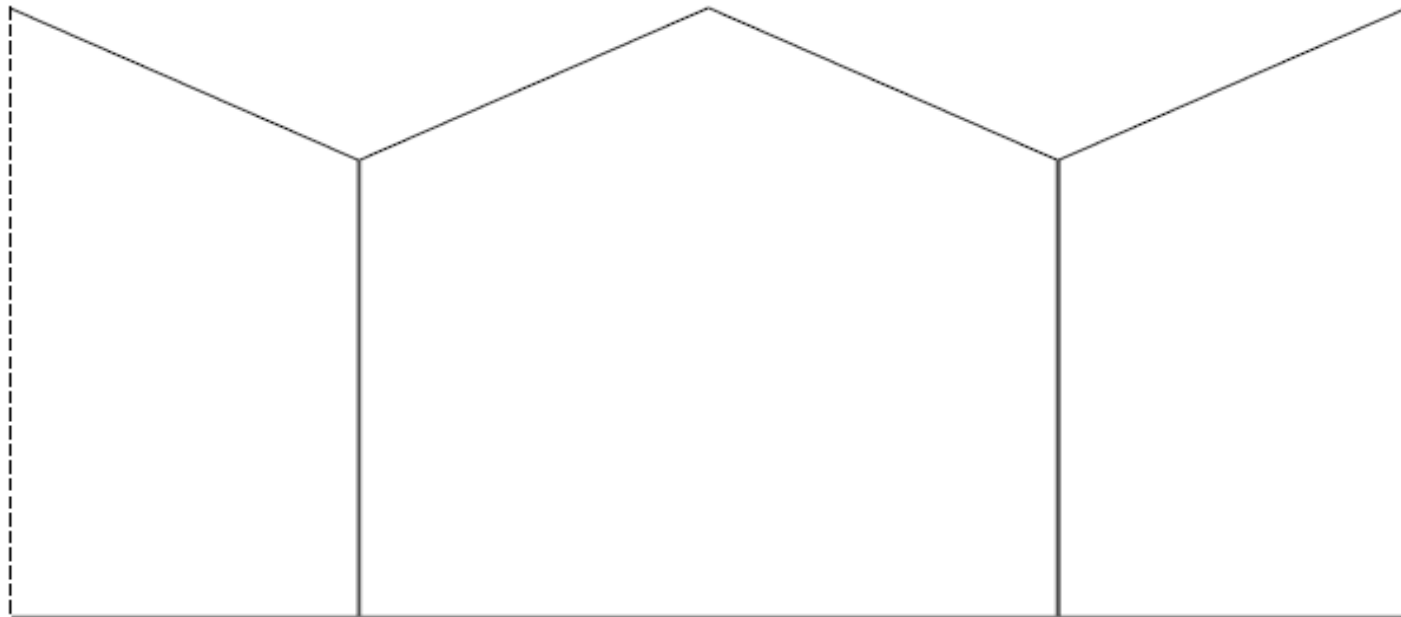

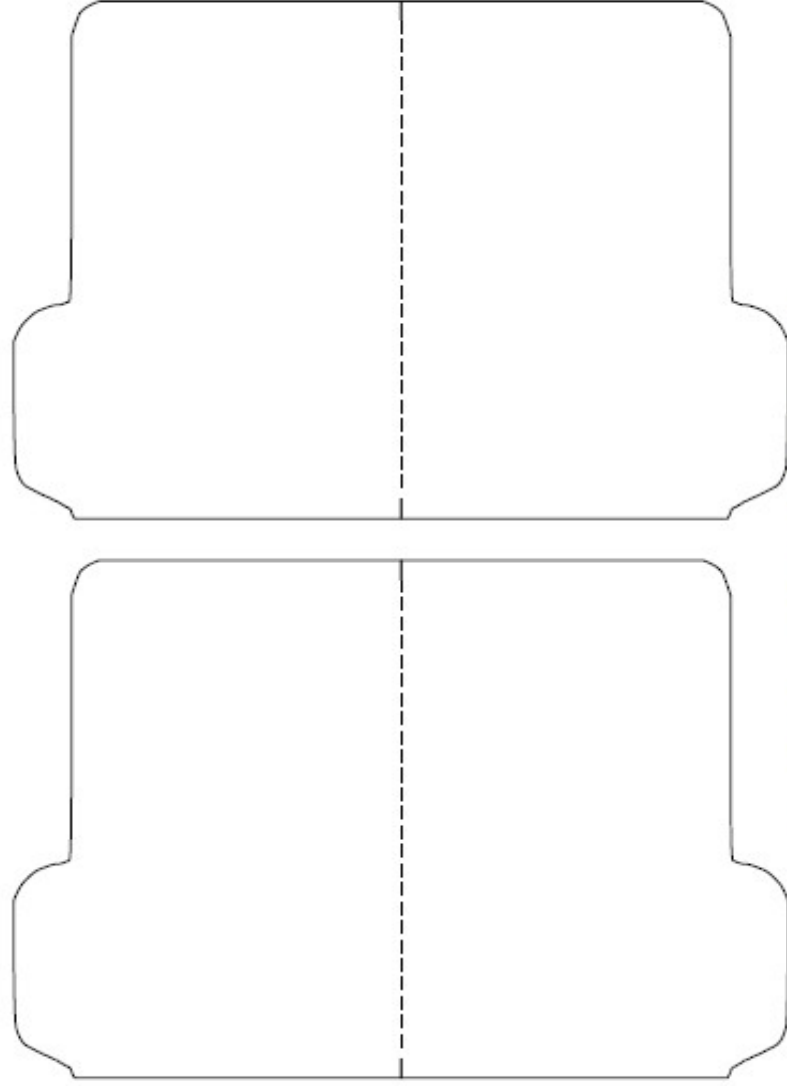
Cut out scroll shapes. Stack together and staple on the top to form booklet.

Cut out rectangle as one piece. Fold on solid lines. You should have a book that opens like the "shutters" on a window.

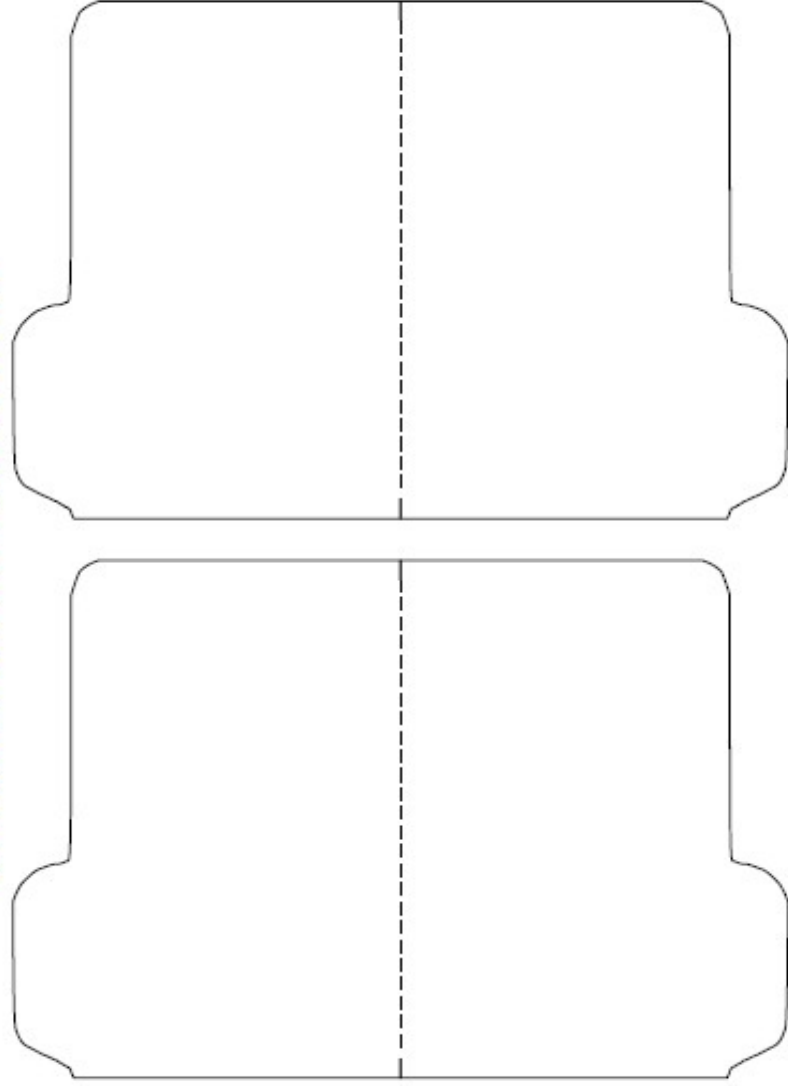

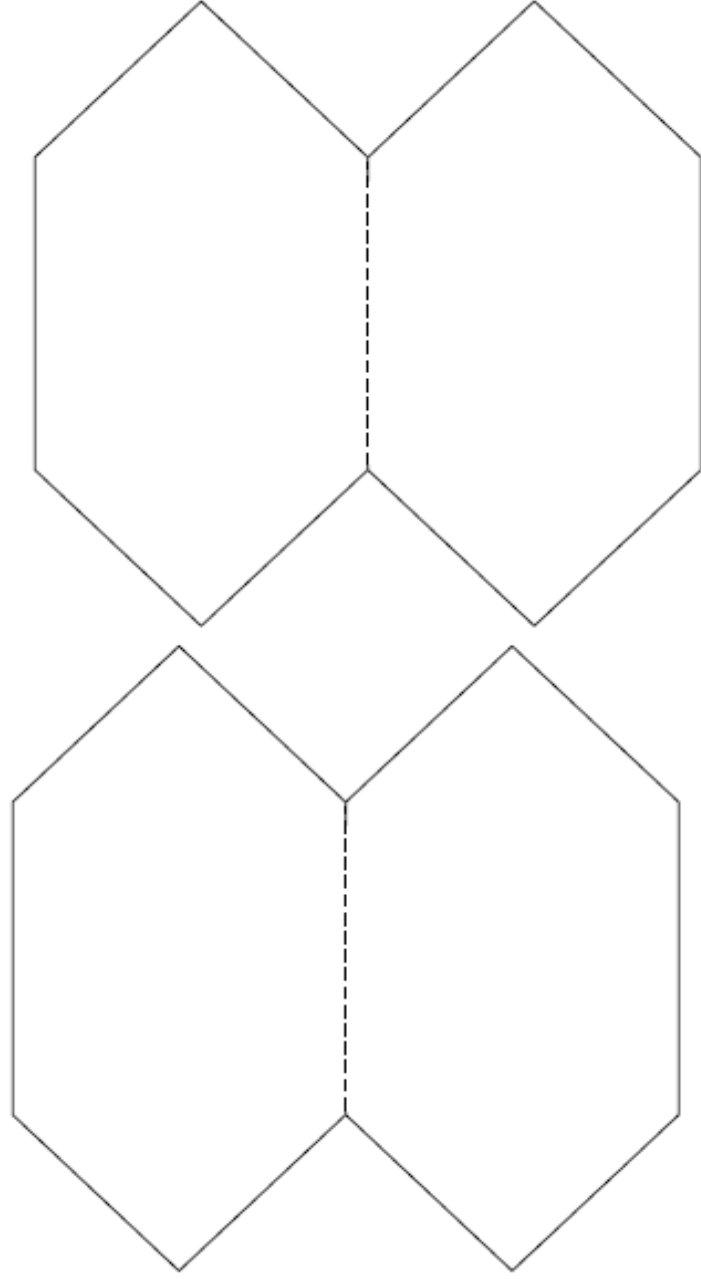

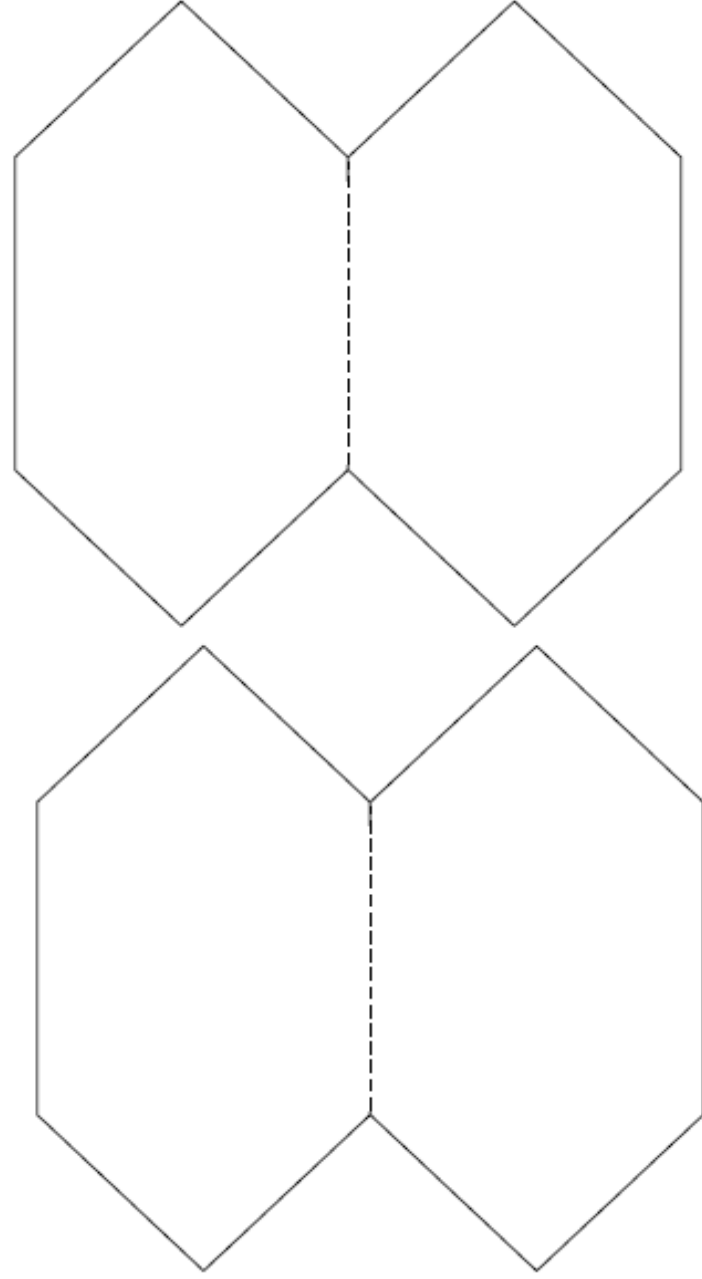
